

## REACH Certificate of Compliance (EC) 1907/2006

Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) regulates the manufacture, placing on the market and use of chemicals and mixtures thereof.

Ritel Ltd. uses parts made of copper alloys.

According to Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, suppliers of articles must inform their customers if the delivered article contains a substance from the REACH Candidate List (SVHC list) in contents greater than 0.1% by mass.

We hereby inform you that Shell and Collet in our knobs are made of copper alloy containing lead in contents greater than 0.1%

Based on information obtained from our suppliers, this document certifies that no other parts in Ritel products contain > 0.1% by weight of the Substances of the Very High Concern (SVHC) as listed by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) under the provisions of Regulation No. 1907/2006 including the new candidate list, which was updated last on June 27, 2024 (241 substances).

Ritel fully supports the aim of Reach in improving the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the properties of chemical substances. As a downstream user, the products of Ritel are non-chemical products that are not designed to release any substance under normal and reasonably predictable application scenarios during their lifespan. Therefore, as per REACH requirements, Ritel products do not need to be registered.

All new designs and solutions provided by Ritel will give due consideration of the need to reduce hazardous substances. We want to point out that the presence of traces of unwanted substances can never be completely ruled out.
